Acceptable Target:	70% of students will earn a B letter grade or better on the AL 430 Final course project 90% of students will complete the AL 390 (To become AL 430 in Fall 2022) Final course project

PSLO 4

Communicates a commitment to ethical practice in health care.

Outcome: Demonstrate problem solving skills related to working independently or in a group

Demonstrated in the course evaluations presented to graduating seniors.

▼ **Measure:** PSLO 4 *Course level Direct - Other*

Details/Description:	Students will complete a survey sent upon completion of the BHS courses related to commitment to ethical practices in health care.
Acceptable Target:	80% of students will complete the senior survey which will have questions related to commitment to ethical practices in health care.

Analysis and Reporting Calendar

PSLOs data collection and reporting will be done in the Fall for PSLO1 and PSLO 2 and then in the Spring Semesters for PSLO3 and PSLO4. Each group of PSLOs will be done every other year.
