Community evacuation and shelter in place

The university has an Emergency Operations Plan in place should a situation or disaster occur.

- If the evacuation of a building (or multiple buildings) is required, the event itself will signal the need to evacuate.
- In the case of a bioterrorism emergency, the Shawnee County Emergency Management office will issue alerts to the local media and Topeka community directing what actions to take.
- If the alert is to shelter in place, everyone should enter a building and remain inside. University Police will communicate the alert to remain inside via:
 - The university e-mail system
 - Voice and text over the emergency notification system
 - Campus-wide voice mail
 - Portable two-way radios
 - In-person and postings, if time permits

Students residing in the Living Learning Center, West Hall, Kuehne Hall and Washburn Village will receive additional notification and direction from Residential Living staff.

Each building on campus has a fire evacuation plan designed specifically for that building.

- The plan provides diagrams for evacuation and establishes evacuation staging sites.
- This document provides evacuation instructions and plans for sheltering in place.
